- Austerity. Diminishing Police budgets
- Service to the public under pressure
- A requirement to do things differently
- A systems thinking review
- Highlighted better ways of working
- A "One team" approach
- Local resources retained / enhanced
- More effective briefing / tasking / deployment

Key benefits:

- One team approach Neighbourhood Policing Teams, Response Teams, Local Crime Investigators, Call takers
- Better demand management
- Less tasking to other departments greater "ownership"
- Start to finish investigation utilising multi skilled team
- Individual point of contact for victims / witnesses
- Upskill Police Officers and staff
- Local Policing coverage 24/7
- More Police units locally based to respond to immediate calls
- Preservation of local officer knowledge
- Retention of local Community/Police contacts


Key risks:

- Remote working functionality and availability
- Key principles of the model not followed:
 - Deploy to operational areas immediately
 - Effective briefing and tasking
 - Effective Supervision

- Pilot area review
- Demand profiling being completed
- Consultation yet to commence
- Planned delivery Forcewide summer/autumn 2016
