1. **Previous minutes-** *Resolved* that these be accepted.
2. **Update on actions /matters arising** – Most actions completed or ongoing. As there were new attendees the minutes were reviewed in full.
3. **Grant Applications-** £1300 remaining
 - i. The Area Board *resolved* this funding will go to support any villages running any VE day celebrations that might need some financial support.
4. **Update on funded projects-**

Older Generations:

- I. M2MT going well and funding to sustain it being sought from NHS (social prescribing) or CCG. Even with Subs of £5 a head it does not cover all the overheads. SC asked DW for a copy of the M2MT accounts to support this.
- II. Memory Café has now outgrown the Fire Station and is moving to the Bouverie Hall. This will incur greater costs for the venue expenses. We expect to apply for funds from somewhere in the new financial year.
- III. Funding for more Canal trips with Bruce Boats with additional support from Marlborough Lions, April 20th Memory Café trip; Churches group will offer 2 trips this year with our support, one older, one youth; our other trip will be later around June time for M2MT members and other individuals nominated by GP's groups or just friends who will benefit from the trip. Bruce Boats will ask Burbage Photographic Club to help members create a scrapbook record our day. Bruce Boats are having an open day April 4/5th 12 to 4pm

Community related:

- IV. Transport remains a priority and our next agenda will focus on sharing what is currently available and where are the gaps.
- V. Adjustable Chairs project successfully concluded with 34 chairs going to 24 villages
- VI. Small amount of Health funding available for VE day celebrations £1400
- VII. PCAP is offering banking and insurance support for small community groups that sign up to our partnership agreement. Currently Grt Bed Walking Group – Insurance and Shalbourne Connect for both.

Youth :

- XII. Fun Day subject to Public Health advice, will take place Fri April 17th. Notices will go to schools. In Messenger I hope. To include an Art Project for VE day.
- IV. Skatepark – Update from Pewsey PC in due time

5. AOB

- I. Brian Holland spoke about the SWARM meetings with CIL (independent Living) and the Christmas Lunch. CIL also runs Make Someone Welcome which feeds into transport (above) as its aim is to support individuals to get to groups.
- II. Maurice Alston spoke about U3A and social prescribing to support isolated local residents to participate in local U3A groups. This is aimed at those visiting the GP regularly but with no real health reason other than those associated with loneliness.
- III. The Rugby Club is now offering its facilities to local groups for hire.
- IV. The Bedwyn Café was suggested for a venue for a Health Meeting so we move around the area.
