

Long-term Potholes in the Pewsey Community Area

Beechingstoke Parish	On the bend as you approach the village from the west after the straight stretch to Patney.
Beechingstoke Parish	South of village at the Puckshipton turn – not only holes, but humps and lumps from treeroots/badgers - who knows – so bad that we have warning road-signs in place, but Highways have done nothing to complete definitive investigations for more than three years.
Grafton Parish	West Grafton – huge pothole. Has been reported and now has a status of closed even though the pothole is still there. Approximately 250cms long x 50cms wide x 10cms deep
Manningford Parish	Seven Wells crossroads – road has literally broken up – reported and sort-of-patched multiple times – site of several collisions a couple of years ago.
Manningford Parish	Woodborough Road, C261 from the Swanborough Tump to Furze Copse – huge pot-holes and verge over-runs – was told by Richard Dobson years ago that this would be assessed for major works.
Manningford Parish/Wilcot, Huish & Oare Parish border	Hare Street, C52. There used to be a ford many years ago and it would be better to have a proper ford with a decent base, dug down below the water level, rather than the awful road full of craters as it is currently.
Wilcot, Huish & Oare Parish	Northbound carriageway, A345 by the bus pull-in – have requested that Wilts Council puts cones/barriers round it to protect cyclists – no response – going to G&H with this one. Reported more than five years ago.
Wilcot, Huish & Oare Parish	Draycott crossroads – major floods and no road markings or anything to indicate a junction to the uninitiated. Reported five years ago.
Woodborough Parish	The Sands, C38 – a cyclist has come off, Malcolm Beaven told us it would be added to the resurfacing schedule, we are now told it is not on the next 5-year plan; this is quite a major north-south/Swindon-Marlborough-Salisbury route for people avoiding the A345.
Woodborough Parish	Massive verge over-run on the bend between Woodlands and Brow Farm Cottages. Vehicles rounding the bend fall into it if they meet a car coming the other way.
